



## CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

The terms of our rental agreement or subcontract require you to provide us with a Certificate of Insurance. The Certificate should show that coverage will remain in force for the duration of the rental period:

The coverages required are as follows:

1. Commercial General Liability with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 (one million). Coverages should equal or exceed that provided by the Insurance Services Office Form CG0001 (11-88). Furthermore, we must be shown as "Additional Insured" on your policy.
2. Inland Marine coverage with a minimum limit equal to the total of all equipment (4Wall Enterprises, yours, and other parties) that will be used in the production. The coverage must be provided on "all risk" or "special" form and pay on the basis of "replacement cost". The policy "coverage territory" should be consistent with the location of the production.

We must be shown as "Loss Payee" on this policy.

3. Automobile Liability coverage for all owned, hired and non-owned vehicles with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 (one million).
4. (Subcontractors only) Worker's Compensation

Attached is a sample Certificate that may be helpful. Please forward this letter and sample Certificate to your insurance agent.
